

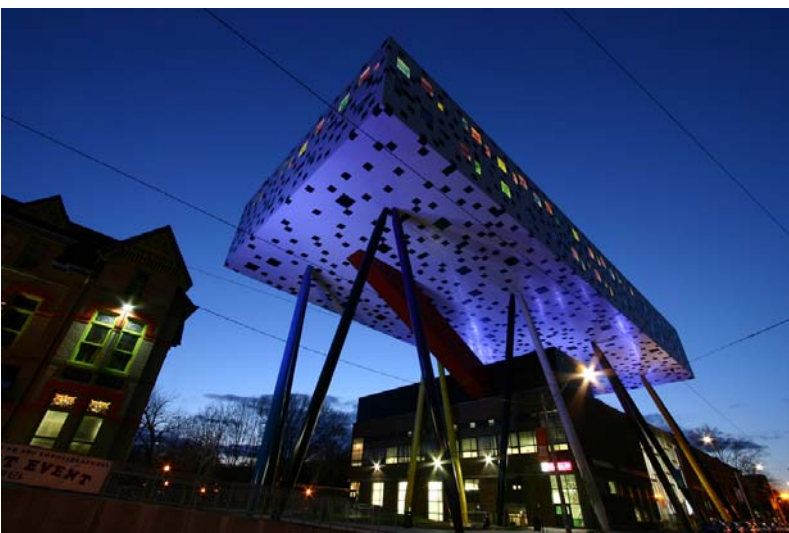

OCAD Ontario College of Art & Design – Toronto ON

The latest addition to OCAD is “The Sharp Centre for Design”, which seems to have landed from outer space. This radical design is fast becoming a Toronto landmark. It consists of a box four storeys off the ground supported by a series of multi-coloured pillars at different angles and is often described as a tabletop. The elevated “table top” extension with its striking black and white pixelated skin and 12 multi-colored legs stands 26 meters above the surrounding mixed Victorian and modern streetscape.



The project consisted of high span curtainwall and custom punch window applications for use in the tabletop. In addition GAM provided ground floor entrances and interior glazing to balustrades and structural glass screens. The unique nature of this project was enhanced by the use of custom colour Vanceva laminated glass in the curtainwall and main entrance.
