The latest addition to OCAD is “The Sharp Centre for Design”, which seems to have landed from outer space. This radical design is fast becoming a Toronto landmark. It consists of a box four storeys off the ground supported by a series of multi-coloured pillars at different angles and is often described as a tabletop. The elevated “table top” extension with its striking black and white pixilated skin and 12 multi-colored legs stands 26 meters above the surrounding mixed Victorian and modern streetscape.

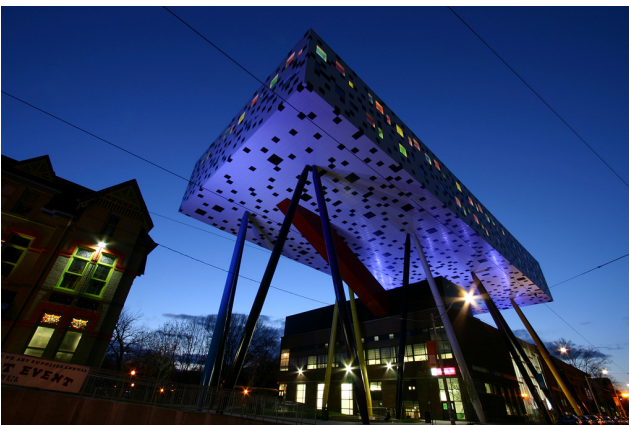


The project high span and custom window for use in the addition provided entrances glazing to and glass unique
